
#10 Climbing the hill the entire way on this hole. An extra club or two is required for approach shot to this two-tiered green.
GD=34 yds.



#11 Our Signature Hole. A tee shot to the 150-yard marker is ideal leaving an approach shot over Holt Creek. A bunker guards the front of this back to front sloping green.
GD=32 yds.




#12 With an accurate tee shot this downhill reachable par 5 yields many birdies. A well-bunkered, multi-tiered green requires an accurate approach shot.
GD=38 yds.



#13 Avoid being intimidated by having to carry the pond guarding the front of this green. Club selection is key on this short par 3.
GD=38 yds.



#14 Accuracy is key on this tee shot. Finding the correct level of this two-tiered green while avoiding the water to the right and behind of this green is important.
GD=30 yds.



#15 A tee shot to the 150-yard marker is all that is required. An extra club or two is required for this approach shot to a green with bunkers short right and back left.
GD=38 yds.



#16 This deep green and the downhill component makes club selection key. Avoid Holt Creek on right side of the fairway.
GD=42 yds.



#17 Accuracy is more important than length on this tee shot. A well-placed tee shot will leave a short approach into this three-tiered green sloping back to front.
GD=42 yds.



#18 This reachable par 5 finishing hole can end your round on a good note. The long, well-guarded green requires an accurate approach shot with distance control in mind.
GD=42 yds.

#1 Don't be fooled by this seemingly relaxed opening hole. Aim for the center of the fairway with driver, fairway wood, or a hybrid. A well-struck tee shot will leave a mid to short iron into the large green which doesn't give putts away easily. Green Depth=35 yds.

#2 A long and accurate tee shot is required on this difficult par 4. Second shot requires accuracy to this long, narrow, well-guarded green. GD=40 yds.

#3 Dogleg left par 4 requires a tee shot carrying the two small ponds at fairway's edge. Mid to short iron second shot to reach the green. GD=29 yds.

#4 Difficult par 3 requires tee shot to carry entire distance to green. The large, undulating green will test even the best putters. GD=43 yds.


#5 Best approach off the tee is to favour the right center of the fairway. Distance control on your approach shot is key to avoid the bunkers guarding the green. GD=32 yds.

#6 This par 5 is best played in three shots. A well-placed tee shot left of center will open up the dogleg for an easier lay up second shot. Your approach shot is key to set up your birdie opportunity. GD=40 yds.

#7 This short par 3 plays tougher than it appears. Avoid being short with your tee shot. Green slopes severely from left to right. GD=32 yds.

#8 This dogleg left par 5 is difficult to reach in two even for long hitters. The green is at least three clubs long with bunkers on the right and left sides. GD=46 yds.

#9 A tee shot carrying the bunkers on the left will leave a short approach shot into the green but is not required. An ideal approach shot is left underneath the hole on this undulating green. GD=36 yds.
